E-Safety Alert - If your children use TikTok, please be aware of the latest craze which went viral on 6th September. To make the lips look plump, TikTok users are spreading glue on their upper lips, then gluing the lip in place.

The primary ingredient in glue is cyanoacrylate, meant to glue things like metal and paper, not the delicate skin of the face. Acrylates can be both extremely irritating to the skin as well as cause true allergic reactions which can result in redness, swelling, blistering, infection, and even more permanent scarring. Since acrylates are toxic, there is also a risk of ingesting them when applied this close to the mouth.

Attendance – A reminder to parents that the gates open for your children to arrive to school and begin learning at 8:30am and close at 8:45am.

If your child arrives after this time they will be registered as late or unauthorised late. It is important for children to feel part of the class routine in the morning and it can be very unsettling for a child to arrive part way through registration, a lesson or an activity that has started. The expectation for your child's attendance is 96%, this is monitored by Mrs Gardner and the local authority every 6-8 weeks.

If the attendance falls below 90% you may be prosecuted. If you have any queries about your child's attendance Mrs Gardner is available, Monday – Wednesday.

Parents Evening – You will be able to book your parents evening appointment from 9am on Tuesday 5th November. Parents evening will be held on Tuesday 12th November with appointments available from 3.30pm – 7.50pm. You can book via your parentmail app. If you are unable to book or need help, please do not hesitate to contact the school office. Letter to follow.

Free School Meals - We want to make sure that we are providing your child with the best education and support we can. Families who receive certain benefits may be eligible for free school meals. Registering for free meals could also raise an extra £1,320 per pupil registered for Bayside Academy. This helps to fund valuable support like additional teaching staff or after school activities and resources. To check if your child is eligible to receive free school meals please collect a form from the office.

Universal Free School Meals – If your child is in EYFS, Year 1 or Year 2 they are automatically entitled to free hot school meals throughout their time in KS1.
