## Year R – Superheroes

### Enquiry Questions

What would be your super powers?	Who can help you in an emergency?	What can you do to help a friend?	
 <p>Who is your favourite superhero? This half term we will continue to learn about people who help us and share our favourite superheroes. We will think about how we can help each other.</p> <p>We will learn about Guy Fawkes night and ways in which we celebrate. We will create our own fireworks pictures and begin to use the sounds that we have learnt in Phonics to write words to describe the firework sounds. We will create our own rockets and practice counting down from 10 to blast off!</p> <p><b>National Curriculum</b></p> <p>We want the children to continue to show awareness of behavioural expectations, to demonstrate friendly behaviour and be confident to talk to others when playing. We will be providing opportunities for the children to engage in taking turns, sharing and working together during our 'play to learn' sessions.</p> <p>The children are learning sounds through the Read Write Inc Phonics programme. They are learning the first 30 sounds in short daily sessions. Please continue to share stories and read at home every day.</p> <p>In Maths, we will be continuing to count objects reliably and recognise numerals accurately. We will learn about shape and size and we will be encouraging the children to use the new mathematical vocabulary they learn.</p>	<p align="center"><b>Ideas for Home Learning</b></p> <p>Home Learning should build your skills and confidence.
