Anti-Bullying Week – Next week, we will be celebrating Anti-Bullying Week and all children will be taking part in activities and assemblies linked to the theme of this year, which is 'Change Starts With Us'. It is coordinated by the Anti-Bullying Alliance, which is based at leading children's charity the National Children's Bureau. We recognise that whether it is verbal, physical, online or in-person, bullying can have a significant impact on a child's life well into adulthood. By making small, simple changes, we can break this cycle and create a safe environment for everyone. Together we can challenge bullying. Change starts with a conversation. It starts with checking in. Children In Need – On Friday 15th November, we will be celebrating Children In Need by raising money with 'Wear Something Spotty'. Pupils can come in to school wearing an item of spotty clothing as part of their uniform to support this charity day. For example, children could wear a spotty hairband, shirt or tie. We are asking for a £1 donation which needs to be paid on ParentPay, all of which will be donated directly to the Children In Need fund.

Road Safety Week – There's less than two weeks to go until Road Safety Week 2019! The theme this year is called 'Step Up For Safe Streets'. On the week commencing the 18th November we will be reinforcing to the children the importance of keeping themselves safe around roads. In line with this, EYFS and KS1 will be taking part in *Beep Beep Day*, which covers road safety basics using fun activities.



Book Bus – The Book Bus is coming soon! The bus will be here on the 27th November for one day only. Children are allowed to bring in some money as they will have the opportunity to visit the Book Bus during the day with their class. The bus will also be on the school playground at the end of the day for parents/carers to visit.



Uniform – We really appreciate the support in ensuring that all children are wearing the correct uniform to school. As well as instilling pride within our school community, this allows for our children’s focus to be purely on their learning. Please remember that all hair ties and hairbands should be small and discreet and plain blue or black in colour, to blend in with school uniform, and that only plain stud earrings should be worn.
