Car Park – As a reminder, the main car park is to be used by staff and official visitors only. For the safety of your children, please do not park in the car park during pick up and drop off times. If your child has a main meal booked they will receive a roast turkey Christmas dinner. If they have a vegetarian or alternative meal booked, they will receive a vegetarian cranberry loaf. The deadline for ordering is 8th December if ordering online or 17th December (midday) if you call them.

TO SEND OR NOT TO SEND? - Often a child will wake up in the morning saying that they feel unwell. Whilst we do encourage children to come to school even if they 'feel a little unwell' we do not want any child who is genuinely ill to come to school. Always try and send your child to school if they are a little 'under the weather' for example with a runny nose, head-ache, tummy ache. The school will always contact you if your child is unwell which is why it is vitally important that we have your correct contact details. However, please do not send your child to school if they have any diagnosed infectious illnesses like chicken pox, measles etc. As the parent/carer you must use your own intuition as to whether your child is well enough to be in school.

Poole Waste Not Want Not - Poole Waste Not Want Not runs a community shop that is intended for individuals and families that are struggling to maintain a nutritious diet due to financial hardship. We are working with a local food bank and 6 suppliers within the community to offer food at a discounted price, or by donation in the case of extreme hardship. Users of the service are able to choose their own food which includes fresh and refrigerated products. Alongside this the service offers support and advice, including a 6 week cooking course, debt management advice and signposting to relevant services in the community.
