PE Expenditure 2020/21

Key Priorities:

This funding will be used to fund improvements to the provision of PE and sport so that pupils develop healthy lifestyles.

What we expect to see:

- Sustainability of development of PE and sports across the Academy
- All children developing healthy lifestyles, primarily through physical activities
- Increased number of children taking part in extra-curricular activities
- High levels of enjoyment of pupils
- Raised attainment and progress from 2019/20
- Raised attendance from 2019/20

Strategy

Teaching and learning:

- Employing specialist qualified coaches to work alongside teachers in lessons to increase their subject knowledge and confidence in PE
- Providing cover staff to release teachers for professional development in PE and Sport
- Employing expert advice to evaluate the school's current strengths and weaknesses in PE and Sport and implement plans for improvement
- Forging links with PE teachers in local secondary schools to help primary staff improve their PE and sports provision e.g. Carter Community School and Oak/Leaf Secondary Schools
- Providing pupils who are gifted and talented in sport with expert, intensive coaching and support
- Continue to develop and embed the 2015 curriculum across the Academy
- Implementing PE HUB planning to improve the standard of PE lessons.
- Widen swimming to ensure pupils who did not complete the course have the opportunity to develop effective strokes and water safety.

Total: £5,120



Leadership and Management:

- Buying into existing local sports networks such as school sport partnerships or community sports coaching initiatives
- Maintaining existing and continuing to establish strong, sustainable partnerships with local community sports clubs
- Maintaining the use of our house system to enable regular, inter-house sports competitions for pupils of all ages
- Maintaining half termly Inter-Academy sporting fixtures
- Maintaining half termly fixtures in team sports.

Total: £3,000

Enrichment Activities:

- Paying staff or external sports coaches to run competitions, or to increase pupils' participation in national school games competitions
- Providing places for pupils in after-school sports clubs and holiday courses
- Every pupil participates in the Annual Sports Day, with some pupils competing in competitive races
- Extra-curricular clubs are on offer to all pupils and further opportunities to engage in team sports
- Replacing worn P.E. equipment and purchasing new equipment/kit as required.
