



### Acceptable Use Agreement for EYFS and KS1 parents/carers and children

A parent / carer should explain the following to their child and tick when they understand.

To stay <b>SAFE online and on my devices</b> , I will:	
1. Only <b>USE</b> devices or apps, sites or games if a trusted adult says so.	
2. <b>ASK</b> for help if I'm stuck or not sure and treat academy computers with respect.	
3. <b>TELL</b> a trusted adult if I'm upset, worried, scared or confused.	
4. Talk to an adult if I get a <b>FUNNY FEELING</b> in my tummy.	
5. Look out for my <b>FRIENDS</b> and tell someone if they need help.	
6. <b>KNOW</b> people online aren't always who they say they are.	
7. Remember anything I do online can be shared and might stay online <b>FOREVER</b> .	
8. NOT keep <b>SECRETS</b> or do <b>DARES AND CHALLENGES</b> just because someone tells me I have to.	
9. I don't change <b>CLOTHES</b> or get undressed in front of a camera	
10. Always check before <b>SHARING</b> personal information.	
11. Be <b>KIND</b> and polite to everyone, online and in person.
